

# FIFTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

## AS WE GATHER

For many years Christians have confidently and boldly sung the hymn, “Stand Up, Stand Up for Jesus.” But have you ever really considered what it truly means to “Stand” for Jesus? As we conclude our “In Christ” sermon series, our journey takes us to Ephesians 6, where the Apostle Paul tells us to “put on the full armor of God so that you can stake your stand against the devil’s schemes.” While this passage is indeed a call to action, Paul assures us that the only way we can “be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power,” is because the Lord Himself is strong for us. Every piece of armor mentioned in the text is connected to a gift that God Himself gives: truth, righteousness, peace, faith, salvation, and even the Word of God itself. These gifts assure us that we are in Christ and He is in us. It is in that truth we stand!

 who spoke by the prophets.




